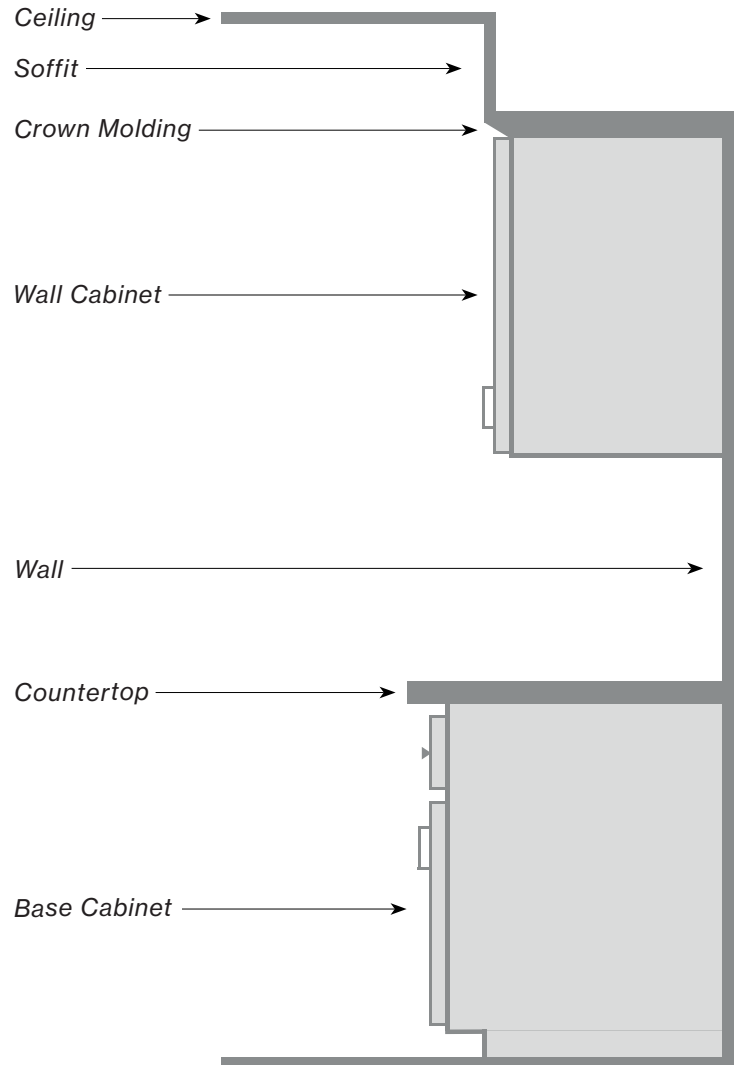

Drawing Your Floor Plan



Use a pencil and the graph below to design your new kitchen.

How to Measure

Tip: Pick a corner to start. Then measure the full length of the wall. Continue around the whole room.



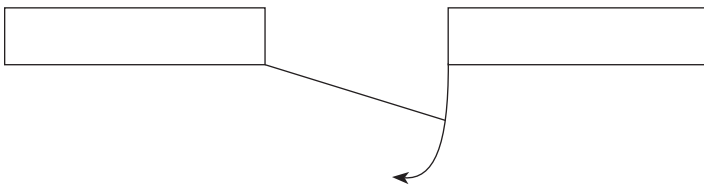
Be sure to measure from the outside of the trim edge to the far wall.



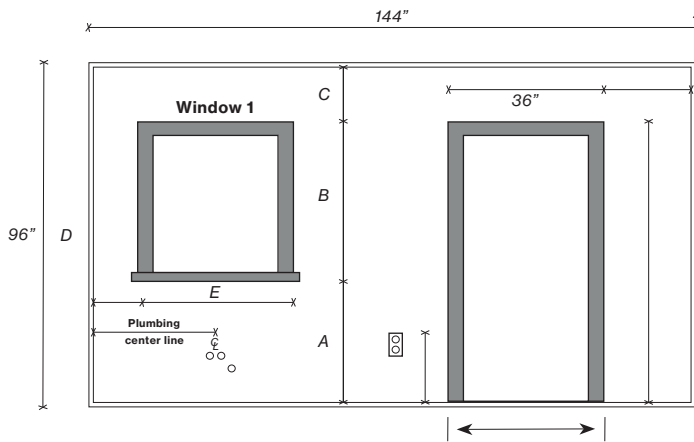
Make sure that all your measurements add up to the overall wall measurements.

Mark all your measurements in inches only, so 7'6" should be marked as 90".

Indicate the direction of the door swing.



Measure all objects on the wall (includes windows, doors, AC vents, electrical outlets, ventilation duct work, gas lines).



Measure all the window and door openings from outside trim edge to outside trim edge.
